Steady Blue	Successfully adopted by a network and working properly.	
Flashing Blue	This is used to locate a device. When you click Locate in the UniFi Network Application, the System LED will flash blue. The Application will also display the location of the UniFi Switch on the map.


This button serves two functions for the UniFi Switch:

Hardware Installation


You have two options for mounting:

- Machine Screws You can use eight M4 machine screws (not included), which must be long enough to extend 6 mm into the Switch.






